GO internet signs an agreement with Enel Open Fiber for the provision of ultrabroadband fibre connection in the EOF project cities

The up to 1 GBPS connection allows for the use of numerous applications requiring ultrabroadband, such as smart TV 4K, real Time platforms, on-line gaming platforms and home automation.
