Scottish Government approved the Millennium wind farm Extension in the Highlands

Milan, 6 February 2017 – Falck Renewables S.p.A. announces that it has received authorization by the Scottish Government to extend the Millennium wind farm, located in the village of Invergarry, 8 km from Fort Augustus in the Scottish Highlands. The site expansion may lead to the construction of 10 new wind turbines.

Now the wind farm consists of 20 turbines and associated infrastructure; each turbine produces up to 2.5 MW of electricity. The wind farm generates enough clean energy to cover the needs of about 27,900 households, contributing to the reduction of dependence on energy sources less environmentally friendly. The site allows, as well, to save 90,000 tons of carbon dioxide every year, that would otherwise be produced by a power plant burning fossil fuel.

"We will evaluate this extension," said **Toni Volpe, CEO of Falck Renewables S.p.A**. "as part of the strengthening and expansion of the Group's policy, as outlined in the Business Plan presented last November. Scotland is confirmed to be a market of great interest for Falck Renewables. The extension of Millennium wind farm will contribute to strengthening relations with local community. At the same time, the Scottish Government is continuing its efforts to build on the great potential of Scotland, which is preparing to become a hub for clean energy."

Falck Renewables S.p.A., a Falck Group company listed on the Italian stock exchange in the STAR segment ("FKR.MI"), develops, designs, builds and manages power production plants from renewable sources.
