## JEAN-LAURENT GRANIER TO BECOME NEW CEO OF GENERALI FRANCE AS OF 1<sup>st</sup> JUNE 2017

Milan/Paris – Generali announces that Jean-Laurent Granier will join Generali Group as Country manager for France and *Président Directeur Général (PDG)* of Generali France with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> June 2017. In his capacity, Jean-Laurent Granier will join the Group Management Committee of Assicurazioni Generali.
