The Villa Santa Lucia plant has resumed cartonboard production

Milan, March 2, 2020 – On February 28, 2020, the Court of Review of Frosinone issued a judgment overturning the seizure of the wastewater treatment plant and granting Cosilam use of the system. Consequently, the Villa Santa Lucia plant resumed cartonboard production on March 1, 2020.

As previously announced, production at the Villa Santa Lucia plant had been temporarily halted as of February 7, 2020, following the seizure order applying to the Cosilam Consortium's wastewater treatment plant rendered by the competent judicial authority.

RDM Group and Villa S. Lucia continue to operate in full respect of environmental laws and remain committed to investments in view of a continuous improvement philosophy.
